ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

We are currently looking for a teacher assistant to join our team. If you are a self-motivated individual with a specific interest in integrating research in clinical medicine, we urge you to apply! In this position, you will be responsible for reading and assigning scientific research articles, assist with creating powerpoint slides and directing questions for student presenters.

MSRE Course format

In this revised course, first-year students are required to read and present research articles in a group. This is commonly known as journal club. Six groups of students have been assigned a theme/topic related to their research interests: Family & Internal Medicine, Emergency Medicine & Cardiology, Pediatrics & OB/GYN, Orthopedics, Anesthesiology & Neuroscience, Surgery & Other. Teaching Assistants will be assigned to work with a group of students to help identify relevant research articles to discuss a week in advance. TA's will help students ask probing questions about the research field and article and link with medical school curricula, as appropriate.

Teacher Assistant Responsibilities:


- Working with the MSRE faculty to monitor the class schedule.
- Assisting faculty with lesson preparation by disseminating research articles in advance
- Discussing research articles with students individually or in small groups.
- Ensuring the classroom environment is safe and clean.
- Collaborating with faculty to recognize issues students are facing and recommend solutions.
- Documenting student progress as needed

- Complying with state, school, and class rules and regulations.
- Attend any training classes and faculty meetings.
